#### **Brian Freedman**



Brian D. Freedman began his tenure as president of the Bay Area Houston Economic Partnership (BAHEP) on January 1, 2023, after serving as president-elect since August 2022. In this role, Freedman leads regional economic development efforts, advocates for key priorities, and works closely with a membership base of over 290 companies, local governments, and educational institutions across 18 cities and two counties.

Before joining BAHEP, Freedman held leadership positions with The Boeing Company and NASA's Johnson Space Center (JSC) in Houston, Texas. At Boeing, he managed state and local government relations, provided strategic legislative counsel, and coordinated outreach with government officials, business organizations, and supplier networks across Texas and Colorado. At NASA JSC, he oversaw legislative affairs, fostering communication and relationships between NASA and U.S. Congress, state and local governments, and space industry groups.

Freedman's commitment to the community is evident in his service with various organizations. He is a past chairman and current board member of the Clear Lake Area Chamber of Commerce and serves as vice chair for Wellby Financial.

Freedman holds a bachelor's degree in management from Mississippi State University, an MBA with a graduate certificate in finance from Colorado State University, and an executive certificate in strategy and innovation from MIT.

Natalie Saiz is currently serving on the Wellby Board of Directors. She brings a member-focused perspective and advocacy to the Board. Post retirement, she continued this relationship by delivering leadership development courses for future government leaders.

While at NASA, she was the recipient of NASA's Exceptional Service Medal, NASA's Outstanding Leadership Medal, and was included in the Honor Roll of HR Executive of the Year for the publication HR Executive.

Portia S. Keyes is a Procurement Manager at NASA Johnson Space Center. She joined the Wellby Board of Directors in 2021 and currently serves as the Board Secretary.
